CONSUMER ALERT: DANGERS OF PET DOORS

New research has found that more than a hundred children have died or been seriously injured in the last decade after squeezing through tiny pet doors and getting into swimming pools or other dangerous places.

"What we see is a picture that's emerging which shows that the pet door is a really serious hazard in a home that no one has really had on the radar screen," said Sean Kane, of Safety Research and Strategies.

Millions of pet owners have installed the devices, to allow cats and dogs to come and go at will. Some of the openings measure 8 by 11 inches, no bigger than a sheet of paper.

In a demonstration, a three-year old was able to easily squeeze through a pet door meant for cats and small dogs.

If you have a pet door please be alert to this danger.
